One Person Can Make All The Difference!

This past Wednesday, as Pastor John took us further into our study in the gospel of Matthew, he started us off with a story shared from Max Lucado's life. The heart of the message: One person can make a difference. One man caring for a group of young boys, choosing to *show up* and God using that man to set the course of one Max Lucado.

Since Pastor John began the study, one theme continues to ring true in my heart; **God seeks to partner with us!** God takes unassuming individuals and places something of Himself in them.

Now, when I look at the men and women in the Bible, it seems to make sense. However, when I look in the mirror, not so much. Maybe it's because they're not my peers and haven't had the time to travel with them a distance and know them; their ups and downs, their weaknesses? Do you know what I mean? But here's what helps me *make sense of it all*:

God has placed something of Himself in each of us, and sets us in motion! That something is [His presence], His Holy Spirit. In doing so, God has chosen to partner with us. God doesn't base the partnership on our level of education, looks, financial status, or our abilities. What God does is He looks at the heart. He looks for a willingness to receive and give, receive from Him, and give to others.

That's what the man in Max's life did! That's what we do when we take our experiences with God and share them with others, whether we facilitate a Bible study, pray quietly for others or send a card or make a call. What has God given you? And is He asking you to share what you've received?
