URGENT: KIDNEY NEEDED

MIRACLE WANTED - I NEED YOUR HELP

Below is an open letter from Geffrey Gruber. Geff recently discovered he was born with one kidney and is now facing kidney failure and needs a transplant.

My name is Geff Gruber. I am 30 years old and this is probably the hardest letter I will ever have to write. You see, at the age of 26, I found out that I was born with only one kidney. Being told that was a complete shock, but also being told that it was starting to fail was even worse.

My dad just died from renal failure and a heart attack on November 14th, 2019. My Mom is a Cancer survivor, which makes it necessary for me to now ask strangers for help. There are thousands of people like me on the waiting lists for a deceased kidney donor, but time is not on my side. Many of us wait for years on the deceased donor list. The average wait time is between 5 and 9 years, depending on where you live. Many of us die while waiting, so my best option is to find a live donor. With a live donor, there is a greater chance of a successful outcome. Kidneys from a live donor last twice as long as that of a deceased donor.

I know this is a huge ask. In fact, the very thought of asking someone for their kidney is overwhelming, but if I don't ask for help now, I could die. My medications, starting dialysis soon and the physical and emotional burden are exhausting and something I would not wish on anyone.
